A work shift will be a minimum of 5 hours and not to exceed 10 hours. These hours may be subject to change with each individual, the number of workers for each event, or if an evening exhibition is scheduled. Workers must be 18 or older to apply.

Pre & Post Game workers and Stockers will be scheduled according to work at hand and hours may vary due to weather or unforeseen circumstance.
